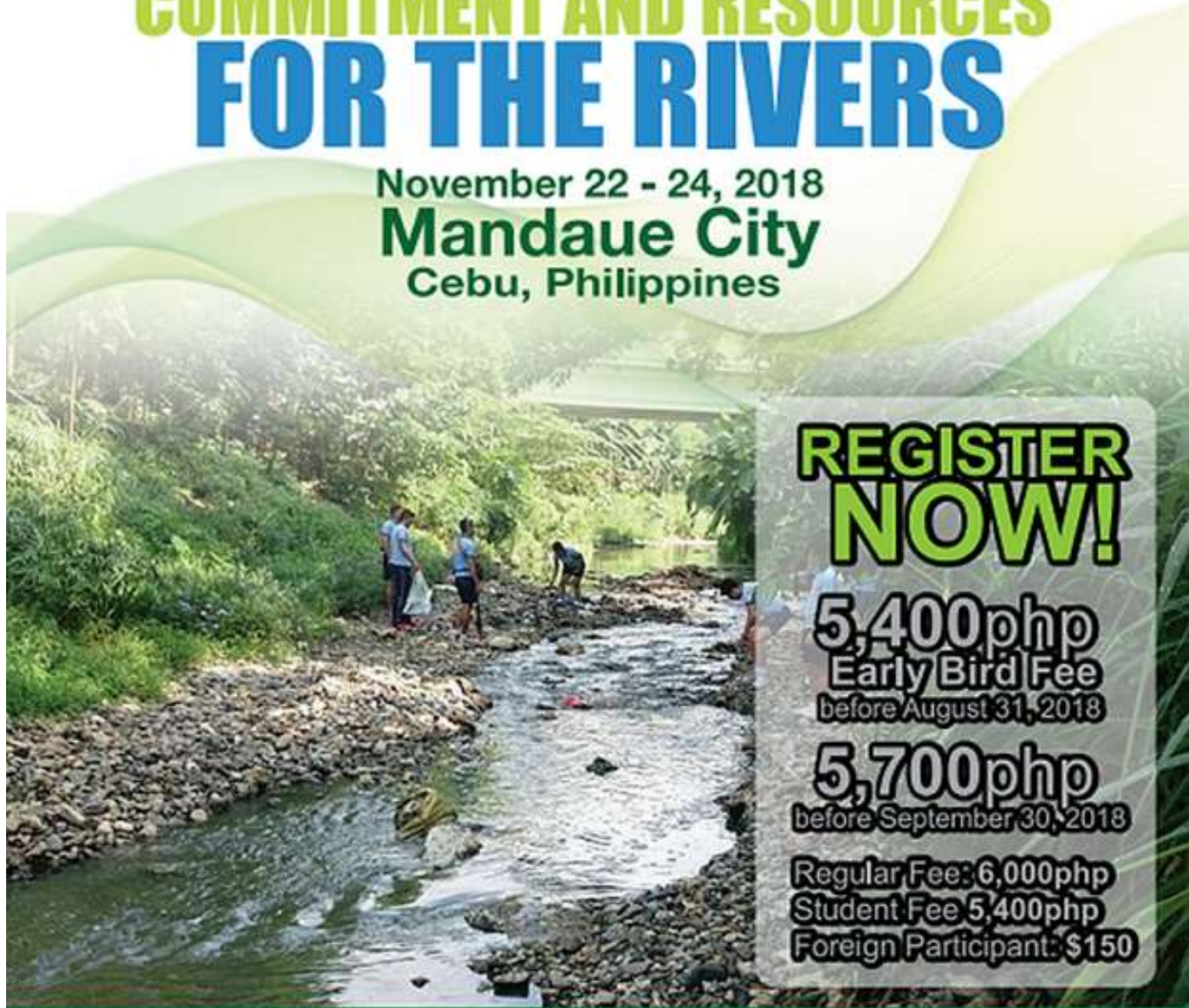

**SUBJECT : 4<sup>TH</sup> INTERNATIONAL RIVER SUMMIT TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 22 -24, 2018 AT THE RADISSON BLU HOTEL, CEBU CITY**


The City Government of Mandaue (Cebu), in partnership with the League of Cities of the Philippines (LCP) and the Department of Environment and Natural Resources-River Basin Control Office (DENR-RBCO), will host the *4<sup>th</sup> International River Summit* to be held on November 22-24, 2018 at the Radisson Blu Hotel, Cebu City, with the year's theme, "Raising Awareness, Resources and Commitment, for the Rivers".

The Summit will convene various river stakeholders, such as, *global, national, and local authorities, policy experts, river managers from public and private sectors, students and the academe, leaders in clean water technology, and other advocates facing development challenges on river management.* The Summit will provide a venue to: (a) foster information and knowledge exchange on latest technologies and trends on basin governance, (b) discuss issues and concerns, and (c) share innovations and solutions to synergize strategies and practices on river basin management.

In this connection, all Provincial Governors, City Mayors and Municipal Mayors are encouraged to allow their respective Local Environment and Natural Resources Officers, or the designated river administrator, if any, to participate in the said Summit. The payment of travelling and other participation expenses may be chargeable against local funds, subject to the availability thereof, and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
