## STRUCTURE

The IMACC is a two-year programme consisting of six modules and a final project or thesis.

Each module has an intensive in-class phase (seven or ten days), allowing for maximum learning opportunities within a condensed period of time. Classes take place approximately every three months at the IACA campus in Laxenburg, Austria (Vienna area) and possibly other locations worldwide.

- Undergraduate degree, equivalent to a bachelor's degree
- Minimum of three years of work experience in compliance, collective action, anti-corruption, law, audit, and related fields, in the private or public sector
- Proficiency in written and spoken English

The overall programme fee is 33,800 EUR, payable in two instalments. This includes all teaching materials and catering during the in-class sessions and excludes accommodation and travel expenses. IACA offers a limited number of highly competitive scholarships for applicants from Least Developed Countries as defined by the United Nations.
