It is also bestowed to Best People's Organization that has significant contribution in their respective communities.

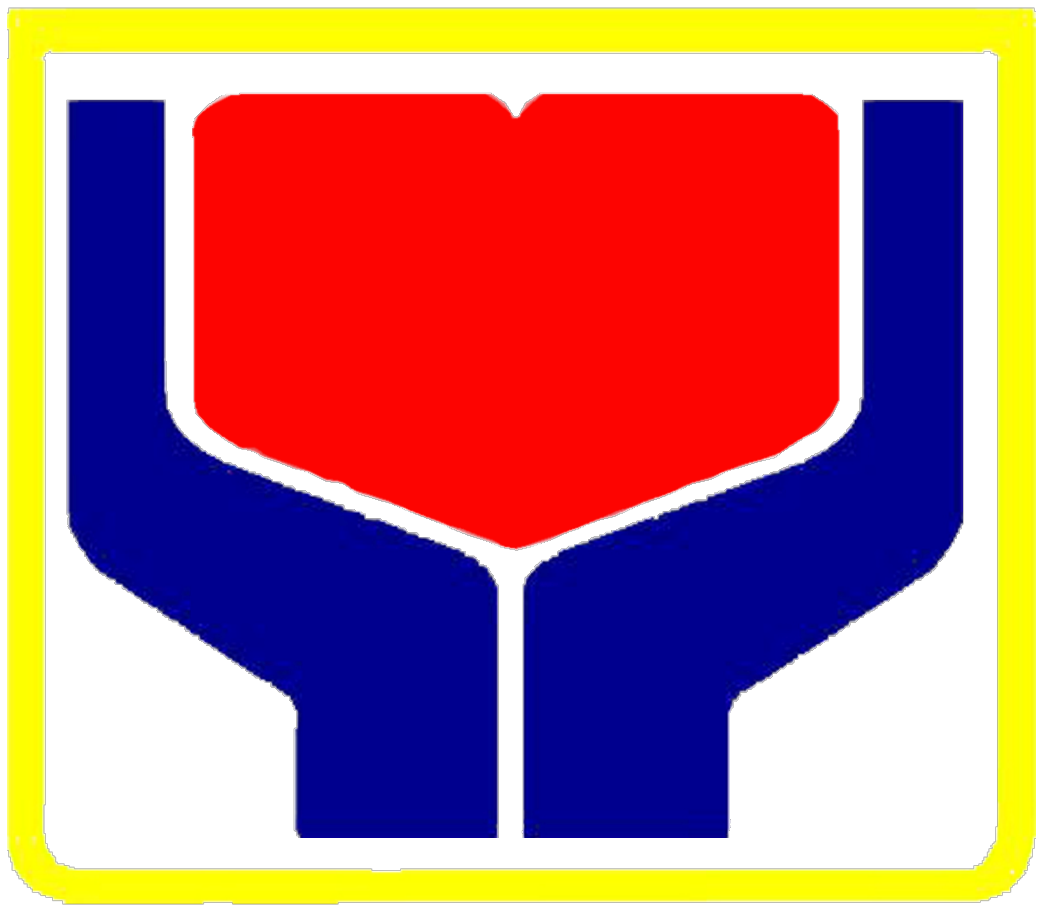
Message from the Secretary
