- A Resilient Community with enhance capacity and capability to adapt and respond to social and economic vulnerabilities, disasters, climate change, as well as emerging threats, and challenges;
- Increase competencies and resilience of relevant stakeholders to improve institutional capacity to address current challenges such as disasters and climate change;
- Promote sustainable financial risk protection for disaster risk reduction and climate change adaptation;
